Arrival at **Casablanca** CMN Airport is followed by assistance of our agent and transfer to your hotel. Breakfast at the hotel. Visit, the old medina, the Mellah (Jew Quarter), the monumental Bab El Mansour gateway, the Place Lalla Adoua, the prison of the Christian slaves, the palace-tomb of Moulay **Ismael** (The only in Morocco, after the Hassan II Mosque in Casablanca which nonMuslims are allowed to enter), the ruins of the Agoudal Busin that was used to water the royal gardens and amuse the favorite concubines, the Moulay Ismail royal stables, granaries and House of Water (Dar El Ma) which were built in the 17th and 18th centuries to house, feed and water the sultan's twelve thousand horses. Have free time for lunch in Meknes. Take off to FES. Check in at Barcelo Medina hotel or similar for dinner and overnight in Fes.

(The driving time between Rabat and Fes via Meknes is 3 hours approximatively and the distance is of 240km)

• Day 4 : FES


Breakfast at your hotel. Morning drive to **Bhalil** which was reputedly built by Irish captives of Moulay Ismael over 300 years ago. Morocco's cherry capital, it is one of the oldest Berber villages in the area. Beautiful drive into the hills. On the other hand, **Safrou** is an interesting town, with an ancient, bustling medina and other walls dating

from Moulay Ismail's day. The town Todra Canyon. Continue to Ouarzazate, the administrative center of the pre-Saharan region. Check in at Oscar Hotel or similar for dinner and Overnight in Ouarzazate. (The driving time between Erfoud to Ouarzazate is 5 hours approximatively and the distance is of 360km)

• Day 6 : ERFOUD / OUARZAZATE

Day 7 : OUARZAZATE/ MARRAKECH

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel. Relax by the hotel swimming pool.

A late morning visit of the town of **Ouarzazate** includes the 17th century **Kasbah Taourirt**, which served as the home of the Pacha Glaoui. Take an afternoon drive to see the ancient **Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou**, an impressive 11th century structure, which has been declared by **UNESCO** to be an historical treasure. A photographer's wonderland, Ait Ben Haddou remains home to five families. Continue driving past scenic views of mountains and semi-desert terrain topped by Kasbahs and adobe homes.

Strolling over the high Atlas Mountains at **TiziN'Tichka** pass (6666 feet), striking contrast of red clay villages and greenery leads us across the fertile countryside of the Haouz Plain to the Ochre city of Marrakech. (The pass of Ouarzazate // Marrakech is considered as one of the most beautiful sites in North Africa).

Check in at **Kech Boutique Hotel & Spa** Hotel or similar for dinner and overnight.

(The driving time between Ouarzazate and Marrakech is 4 hours approximatively and the distance is of 210km)

• DAY 8: MARRAKECH / CASA Breakfast at the hotel. Marrakech.

second of the four Imperial cities, rose-red-oasis at the foot of the High Atlas Mountains, founded in 1062. Your morning historical visit will include: the ramparts, the stately 12th century Koutoubia minaret, designed by the same architect as the Giralda in Seville and Tour Hassan in Rabat, the secret 16th century tombs of the Saadian Dynasty, notice the wonderful Hispano-Mauresque architecture surrounding the burial ground of the royal family, the Menara Gardens, where we see the small Saadian Pavilion mirrored in still water with the Atlas Mountains and olive groves in the background. Sultans used this pavilion for romantic interludes. Afterward a visit to the aristocratic Bahia Palace (former home of a 19th century Grand Vizir), shows us a lush Moorish style gardening the courtyard of a large palace with beautifully painted residential rooms. And finally, a stroll through the souks of the Medina and the famous Djamaa El F'na Square the meeting point ancient of tradesmen in Northwest Africa, with its entertainers. dancers. acrobats. jugglers, storytellers, public-scribes, soothsayers, medicine-men,

snake-charmers. Back to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure or to explore the **Old medina** of Marrakech with its souks, especially the Jamaa El F'na square where the entertainment begins late in the afternoon.



• DAY 4 : RABAT / CHEF-CHAOUEN

• DAY 5 : CHEFCHAOUEN / MEKNES / FES

You will soon reach Meknes, third of the Imperial Cities, built by the 17th century Sultan Moulay Ismael, contemporary of Louis XIV of France, whose grandiose building schemes he imitated. Visit, the old medina, the Mellah (Jewish Quarter), the monumental **Bab El Mansour** gateway, the Place **Lalla Adoua**, the prison of the Christian slaves, the palace-tomb of Moulay Ismael

(The only mosque in Morocco, after the Hassan II Mosque in Casablanca which non-Muslims are allowed to enter). the Moulay Ismail royal stables, granaries and House of Water (Dar El Ma) which were built in the 17th and 18th centuries to house, feed and water the sultan's twelve thousand horses. Have free time for lunch in Meknes. Take off to FES. Check in,

(dinner and overnight at the hotel).

• DAY 6 : FES

Enjoy a tasty breakfast at the hotel, then embark on a full day city tour of **Fes**, the most ancient of the four Imperial Cities, founded approx. in 809 A.D. Fes is the spiritual and cultural heart of Morocco; it has harbored some of the most celebrated thinkers and scholars of the Jewish community and its religious institutions and libraries are legendary, its mosques of great renown.

Your visit will include: the Jewish cemetery, a synagogue, the Mellah, Maimonides clock, the 15th century Borj Nord Arm museum, the great gateway of the Royal Palace, the imposing fortifications of the 17th century Kasbah des Chrardas, the 9th century Karaouyine Mosque and University (the second most important Islamic University in the world after El Azhar in Cairo) with its Madrassas (colleges) of Bou Inaninia and Attarine that date back to the 14th century, the shrine of Moulay Idriss II, founder of Fes, the tanneries, the 19th century Makina-armament factory where carpets are made nowadays, the Nejarine fountain, as well as the Bab Boujloud gateway, the spice market, the guilds and souks of the Medina. Vibrant, noisy, fascinating and overwhelming – this city is a visual and pungent feast for the senses that will certainly leave a lasting mark on you. Sightseeing with a guide.

(Dinner and folkloric entertainment at a local restaurant and overnight at the hotel).





• DAY 7 : FES / IFRANE / AZROU / BENIMALEL

After breakfast we start our journey towards Benimalal, driving through the Atlas Mountains and passing through the Berber village of Imouzzer El Kandar and the town of Ifrane. The road crosses the country of Zayane, punctuated by small villages and forests of pines, oaks and cedars. Photo stop at Lake Ahmed Lhansali which enjoys a magnificent panoramic view. The pieces from the El Badi Palace were used to create a new palace in Meknes, leaving just the shell of the palace behind. Continue to the souks, the largest you can find in Morocco. We suggest you try haggling as it is an inherent part of Moroccan trading culture. In the afternoon, visit of the famous Jamaa el-Fnaa, the commercial and cultural center of the city, Jemaa el-Fna represents a UNESCO-designated Masterpiece of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity. The square hosts daily performances by storytellers, actors, and musicians. Merchants come and go throughout the day, selling fresh orange juice, traditional foods, herbal medicines, traditional water bags made from leather, and brass drinking cups. Dinner and folkloric entertainment at a local restaurant in Marrakech.

(Overnight in Marrakesh Hotel).

• DAY 10 : MARRAKECH / AGAFAY CAMP

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel, then head towards **Agafay**. Agafay is a desert near Marrakech, often neglected by the general public. Discover the rocky and desert plains of the superb Atlas. Take a break to admire the lake of **Lalla Takerkoust** and enjoy a mint tea. For lovers of preserved nature, for travelers in search of discovery and authenticity, Lake Takerkoust is known for its mild and pleasant climate. The Agafay Desert is located just a few kilometers from this body of water.

(Dinner and overnight at Agafay Camp).

• DAY 11 : AGAFAY / AGADIR

After breakfast, embark on a very pleasant journey to **Agadir**, the largest seaside resort in Morocco. From the top of its hill where the ruins of the Kasbah stand, the view covers the city and its endless beach of fine sand. Free time for lunch (own account). Afternoon is dedicated to the visit of the city by the ruins of the Kasbah, vestiges of the terrible earthquake of the last century, the port, Agadir Oufelat and Talborit.

(Dinner and overnight at the hotel).

• DAY 12 : AGADIR / ESSAOUIRA

Breakfast is followed by a transfer to Essaouira, also called "the former Mogador" on the Atlantic coast for the guided historical tour of the Skala of the city and the port, the old military monuments that date back to the 18th century, the Portuguese Skalas of Essaouira which are now considered a mythical place, the old medina is now classified as a world heritage site by UNESCO, it largely preserved its authenticity on the level of the design and the forms as well as on the level of the materials; its souks include all the craft trades and several traditional markets, the consulate district and the Mellah (Jewish district). Lunch and free time to explore at your own pace the interior of the ramparts which shelter this medina with Portuguese and Moorish influences. 





I, the burial town of the founder of the first Moroccan kingdom and is a historic mosque and its famous place. Then we continue our journey to the medina of Meknes, the walls of this medina are grant. It is home of the splendid mausoleum of Moulay Ismail. We will explore Bab lekhmiss, then they Jewish quarter called El Mellah and the Sahrij Swani. This is one of the prestigious Historic Monuments of Meknes. This artificial lake is also impressive by its size, about 148.75 m2 by 319 m2. The lake was used to store food and water for the "black Army" of the sultan Moulay Ismael. We can visit the mausoleum of the sultan and admire the Arab-Andalusian style and Place El-Hedime [Square of Ruins] which links the medina and the Kasbah. Spend some time exploring this charming City. Late afternoon, we head to Fes. Arrive in Fes and spend the evening at leisure. (Overnight in Fes).

• Day 5 : Fes

Today you will discover the city of **Fes**, the spiritual and cultural heart of Morocco; vibrant, noisy, fascinating and overwhelming — a visual and pungent feast for the senses. Head into the old city, known locally as Fes el Bali, arguably the world's most fascinating and confounding old city. Medieval Fes was one of the world's great centres of education and culture, both Islamic and Jewish. Its religious institutions and libraries are legendary, its mosques of great renown. Walk through the twisting streets and alleyways, passing donkeys piled high with goods,

and explore the specialty sections that

divide the souk. Filled with historic

khans, medresses and dye-pits, stalls loaded with fruits, herbs and soups, and where the squawk of chickens, smell of spice and sound of hammering of copper fills the air, it's not hard to imagine yourself back in the Middle Ages. Spend the day exploring the old city, visiting, Medresse el Attarine, the tanneries and the splendid Fondouk Nejjarine, a beautifully restored 18th century inn. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and perhaps spend the evening relaxing in this calming oasis, away from the buzz of the medina.

• Day 6 : Fes / Ifran / Midelt / Ziz valley / Merzouga

After breakfast, we depart to **Erfoud**. A long the way, you'll pass via Azrou Cedar forest and stop for monkeys pictures. On the way, stop at **Ifrane** for some pictures. Carry on through the High Atlas Mountains and the valley of **Ziz**. We pass Errachidia, the city and capital of the province. You enjoy the picturesque valley of Ziz valley and Tafilalet oasis of palm trees. Continue along the palm groves and pass the city of Erfoud. Reach the little town of Merzouga and check into the hotel.

• Day 7 : Merzouga

Today's itinerary reconciles with Fez Merzouga long distance. Time will be devoted to explore around ERG Chebbi. We tour the Sandy dunes of Erg Chebbi that stretches in the Sahara desert across 30 km long and 10 km width. It is a gift from nature, and it inspires locals and guests alike. Sunrise and sunset are among the highlights. In the same day, we meet

nomad families who take care of their animals. They live in nomad tents and they depend on grazing to win a living. We head to Rissani to visit the local market and to explore examples of ancient villages. Sleep well!

• Day 8 : Merzouga / Tinghir / Ouarzazate

After breakfast, depart to **Tinghir** via Rissani and Tinjdad. Tinghir is a gorgeous, 40km oasis, which boasts one of the largest palm groves in the country. Enjoy walking at the famous **Todra Gorge**, a 300m wall, carved deep into the High **Atlas Mountains**. Leave to **Dades** and its charming valley. Continue along to **Kelaat M'Gouna**, a large village famous for cultivating roses. Expect to find many fine, rose-infused products there. Transfer to **Ouarzazate**, also known as "Morocco's Hollywood," for dinner and overnight.

• Day 9 : Ouarzazate / Ait Ben Haddou / Imlil

Enjoy the city tour of Ouarzazate, beginning with the Taourirt Kasbah. The latter is considered one of the most beautiful Kasbahs in the country. Next, visit the film studios, where some of the most famous desert landscapes were and are still being shot. Continue on to the spectacular fortress of Ait Ben Haddou, the iconic landscape immortalized in such films as, Lawrence of Arabia and Gladiator. Later leave for Imlil, a small village in the high Atlas Mountains of Morocco. We will drive through the Ounila Valley that leads along the stunning road to the Kasbah of Ait Benhaddou, the oldest and most famous Kasbah in Morocco and a UNESCO World Heritage site. In the afternoon, we venture into the new city and visit the Majorelle Gardens - a magical petite garden estate designed by Jacque Majorelle and maintained by Yves Saint Laurent. After the tour, we return to our hotel and have the rest of the day
